Message from the Fayette County Attorney

This past year marked a period of meaningful growth, collaboration, and service for our office. We strengthened Child Support Services by becoming fully staffed for the first time since before COVID, welcoming three new attorneys and adding a dedicated receptionist, while also improving courthouse operations to create a smoother, more respectful experience for families seeking support, payments, and paternity services.

Through innovative efforts, including a successful pilot project and focused enforcement, we secured over \$2,000 in additional child support payments that directly benefited children and families in our community. Beyond the courtroom, my office and I expanded our outreach through a new social media presence, speaking engagements at schools and neighborhood associations, and continued participation in community events and law enforcement training. I am proud to continue to support professional development for our prosecutors, represent the Fiscal Court in significant legal matters, and contribute to statewide policy through my appointment to the Attorney General's inaugural Child Support Services Council.

Most importantly, we celebrate the personal victories that remind us why this work matters—like a non-custodial parent making her very first payment after achieving sobriety. Together, these efforts reflect our ongoing commitment to fairness, accountability, and service to the community we are honored to represent.

I am grateful for the progress we've made together in the Fayette County Attorney's Office. This year reflects our continued commitment to transparency, community engagement, and justice. These accomplishments are possible because of our dedicated team and the support of this community. It remains an honor to serve as your Fayette County Attorney, and I look forward to continuing this work together.

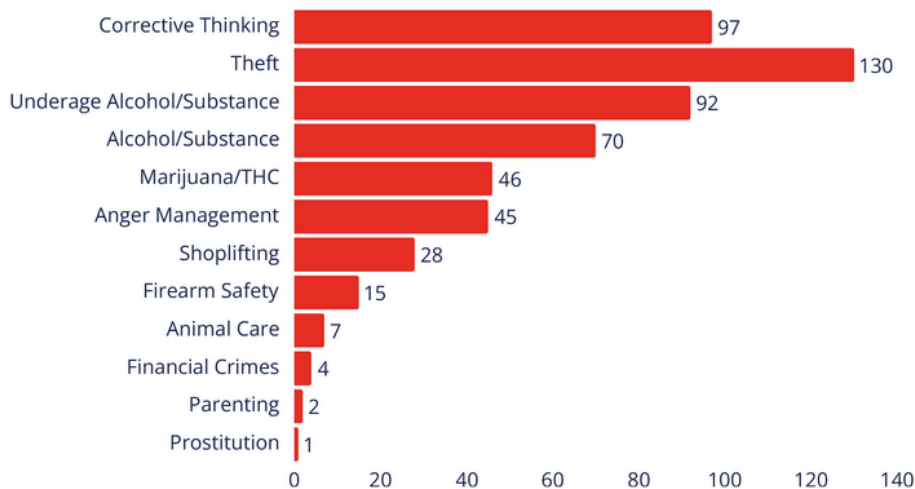

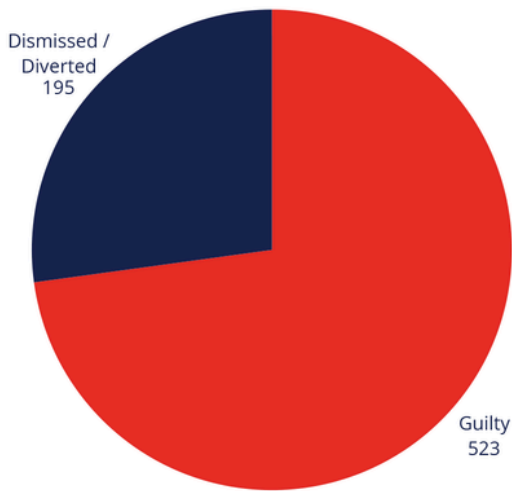

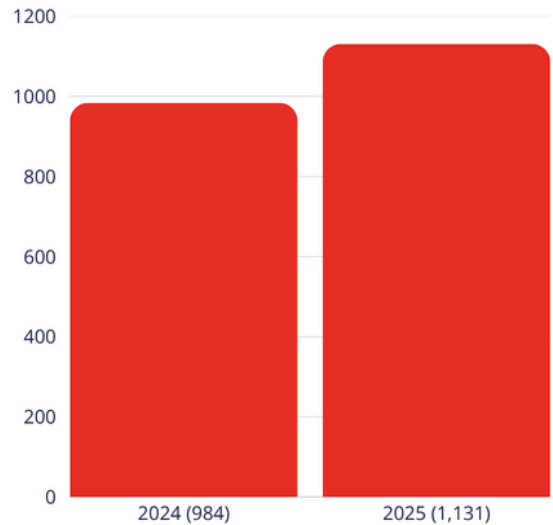

Disposition of Resolved Domestic Violence Cases



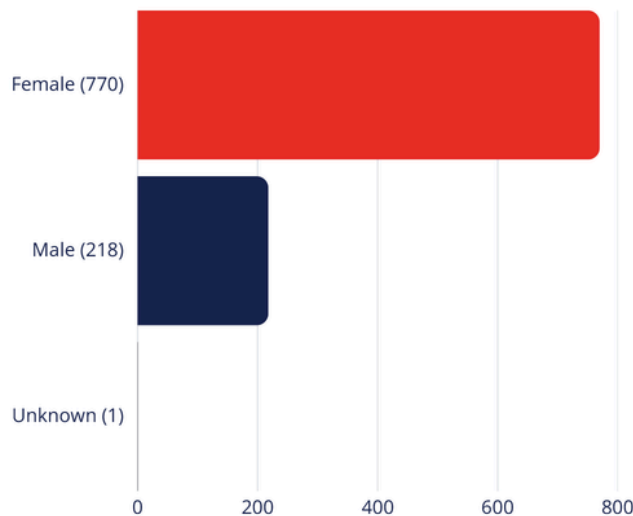
